Post Code CA13 0SR (but that only gets you to the village)

From the M6/A66

From M6 Junction 40 (Penrith), take the A66 for Cockermouth.

At Cockermouth, turn left at the Premier Inn onto the A5086.

If travelling via Carlisle, leave Carlisle on the A595, turn left at the junction with the A66 then turn right at the Premier Inn onto the A5086.

Take the second left after the Premier Inn, signposted to Mosser 1.5 miles.

Remain on the main road, ignoring turnings on the left to Brandlingill and the right to Pardshaw.

After about 1.5 miles, go through Mosser, where there is a sharp right hand bend shortly followed by a sharp left hand bend.

Shortly after these bends, take the left fork (there is a signpost marking this road to Loweswater as unsuitable for motors, but the road up to High Mosser Gate is maintained – sort of) and continue up the hill and past Mossergate Farm on the right.

High Mosser Gate is the light cream building on the left, about 200 yards after Mossergate Farm.

From Egremont etc. travelling north on the A5086:-

After the turning to Ullock on the left, you will pass some signs to Pardshaw on the right. Following these, there will be the Old Posting House Inn on a road junction on the left. Shortly afterwards, by a slight bend to the left there is a (very easy to miss) turning on the right, signposted to Pardshaw Hall. Take this (if you miss it then take the next right to Mosser and follow the directions above). At the next T junction, turn left, then right at the following T junction. This takes you into Mosser, then follow the remaining directions above.
